



# Examples of PPE for Different Operations

## EXAMPLES OF PPE FOR DIFFERENT OPERATIONS

Activity	Hazard	PPE	Others
Chemical preparation	Chemical spillage  Slip and fall	Respirators, nitrile gloves, wet boots	Prepare spill kits (mops) to clean spillages Aluminum tray to contain spillages
Spraying	Accidental contact with chemicals (eyes, inhalation, etc.) Chemical spillage Heat stress Slip and fall	Appropriate facemasks/respirators, goggles, double-sided aprons, nitrile gloves, wet boots	Clean water should be allocated to all teams for cleaning in the event of contact with eyes etc.
Manuring	Accidental contact with chemicals (eyes, inhalation, etc.) Chemical spillage Heat stress Slip and fall	Dusk mask, goggles, hand gloves, double-sided apron	Clean water should be allocated to all teams
Harvesting	Slip and fall Falling fronds and debris  Sharp sickle Sharp thorn	Goggles, hand gloves, high boots	Training on correct positioning of pole length
Trunk injection	Very toxic chemicals Chemical spillage, Slip and fall, Sharp objects	Appropriate respirator, goggles, double-sided apron, nitrile gloves, boots	Safety training Scheduled health surveillance
